- How does information sharing empower the criminal justice community and what success is attributed to N-DEx System usage?
- What are some capabilities and features of the N-DEx System that can aid my investigations?

These sessions, conducted through Microsoft Teams, are designed to instruct criminal justice professionals on ways the N-DEx System can aid their investigations. Participants will receive guidance on how to access system capabilities; utilize best practices for setting system preferences; conduct effective searches on targets of investigative interest; and employ timesaving features such as subject alerts to automate investigative workloads and aid in deconfliction.
